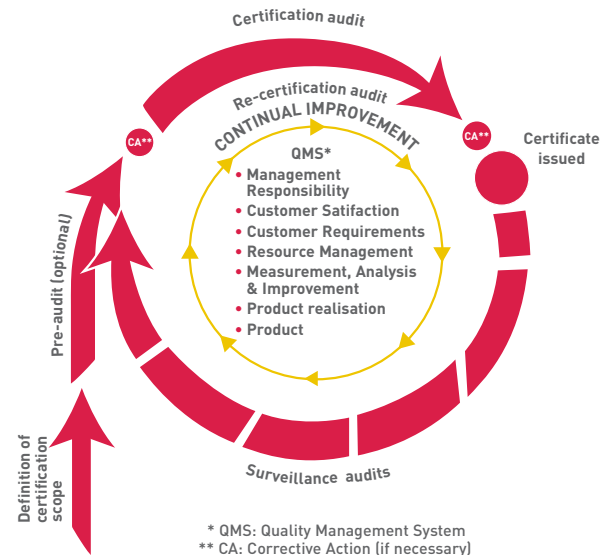
OUR CERTIFICATION PROCESS

- Definition of certification scope;
- Pre-audit (optional): gap analysis and diagnosis of your current position against the standard;
- Certification audit (certificate issued);
- Surveillance visits to follow the continual improvement;
- Re-certification after 3 years through full audit or continual assessment;
- Following each step a straightforward and complete report is delivered promptly allowing your company to continually improve its quality management performance.

To which industries do the AS/EN/JISQ 9100 family of standards apply?

AS/EN/JISQ 9100 is applicable to the whole supply chain, not only in the aeronautics manufacturing industry, but also in equipment design and fabrication, operation of airports and airways, supply and maintenance of spare parts, flight operation and goods processing.

- EN/AS/JISQ 9100 is applicable to companies producing new materials, parts and other materials.
- EN/AS/JISQ 9110 is applicable to companies carrying out maintenance and repairs.
- EN/AS/JISQ 9120 is applicable to stockists and resellers.

The AS/EN/JISQ 9100 series of norms and the procedures for application have been passed by the IAQG (International Aerospace Quality Group) and, for Europe, by the EAQG (European Aerospace Quality Group) and ASD (AECMA-EASE).
